The notes have the values of $£ 5, £ 10$ and $£ 20$ (from smallest to greatest). Lina and Sam have the same amount of money - they both have $£ 20$.

Any explanation that shows an understanding that Ben has more money as he has $£ 20$ but Amina only has $£ 15$. Children should also show understanding
 that the total value depends on what the notes add up to - not how many notes there are or the number on one note.

Accept any correct answers that children give.
