Exploring texture: Creating a texture board

Today we are going to explore texture by painting on different material surfaces.

You can choose any materials you have around your house. For example: tin foil, cling film, baking paper, newspaper, a bun case, paper doily, cotton wool, kitchen roll, toilet paper, fabric, string, bubble wrap, cardboard, sandpaper, egg box, egg shell, pasta, rice or anything you have to hand.



First you are going to take a selection of your items. Cut or tear them and glue them randomly on some paper or cardboard. Like in the picture. You can use pritt stick or PVA. The items can be glued randomly and overlap... this is your choice.

Try not to use too much glue as we don't want it to go soggy and we need it to dry.



Leave your texture board to dry, ready for this afternoon!
