

Twists with Tables – Mental Maths Webs

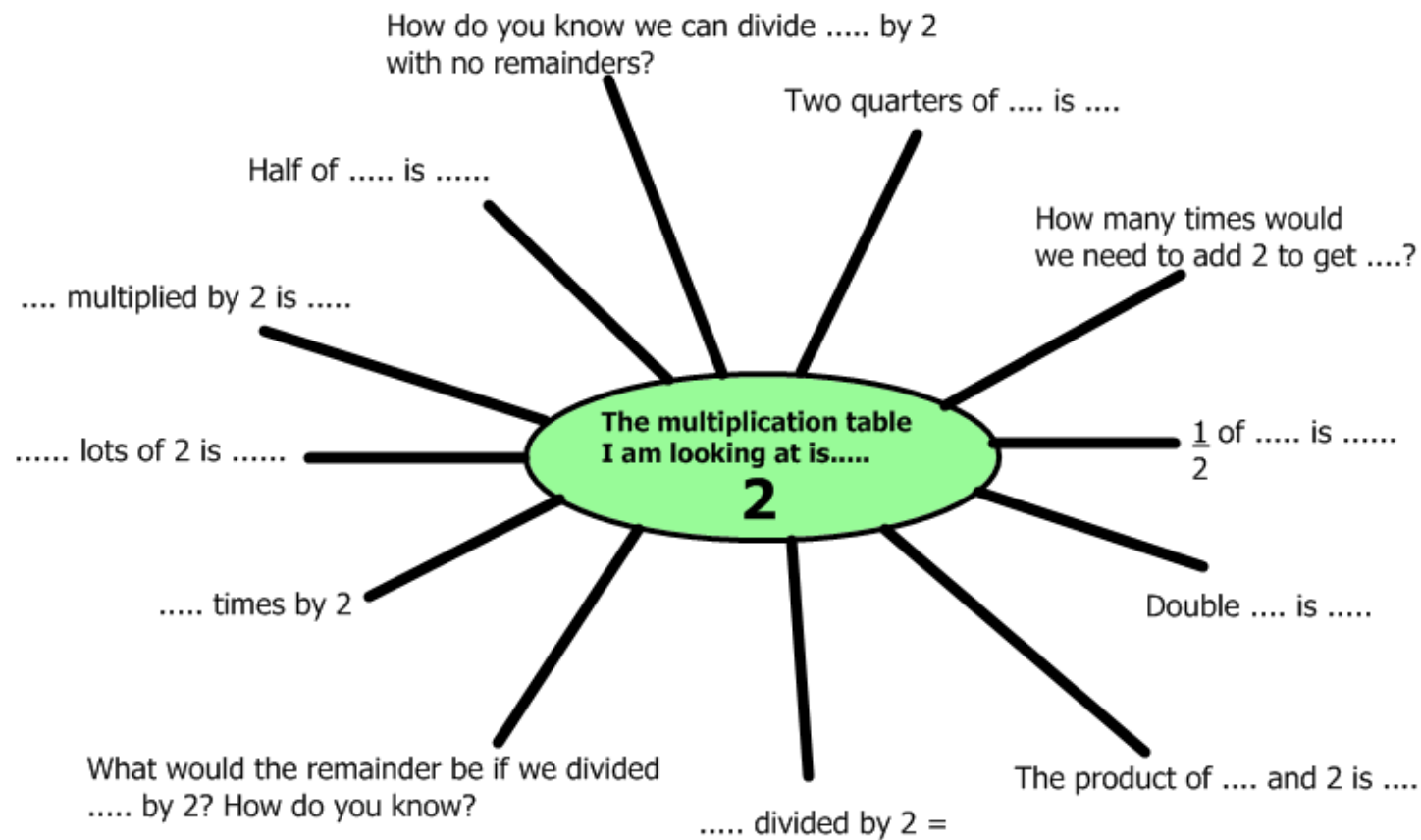
Each web looks at a different table and there is also a blank web to explore other multiplication tables.

The idea is to explore all the different language related to the chosen table as soon as the children are familiar with multiplication table in recited in order or randomly. This activity explores the language and understanding of their tables and division facts further.

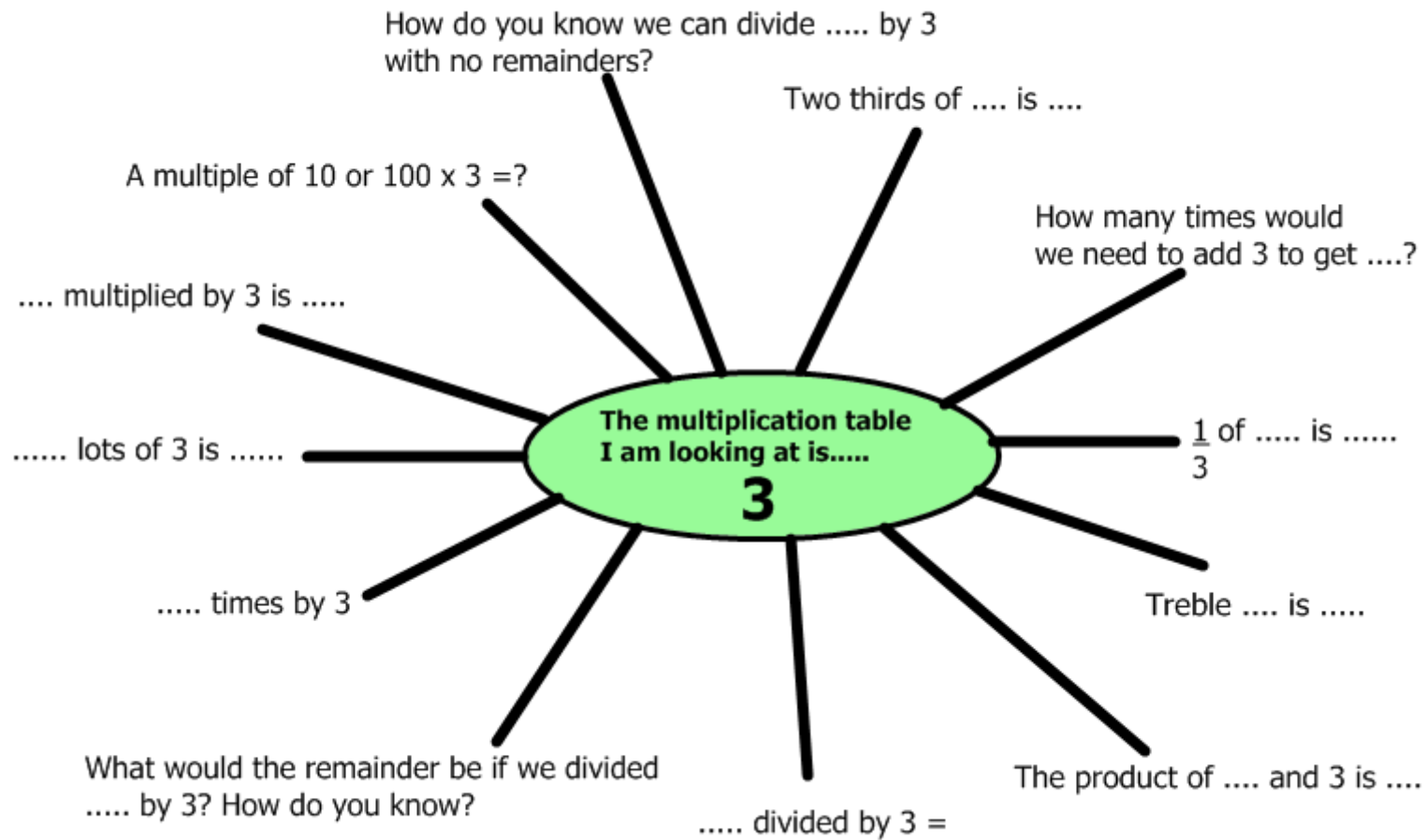
You may not want to look at the whole web and just focus on parts to begin with.

It may be useful to model how you would work out each of the calculations mentally and provide modelled jottings for children to see how similar all of the calculations are; it is just the language that is allowing them to 'appear' different.

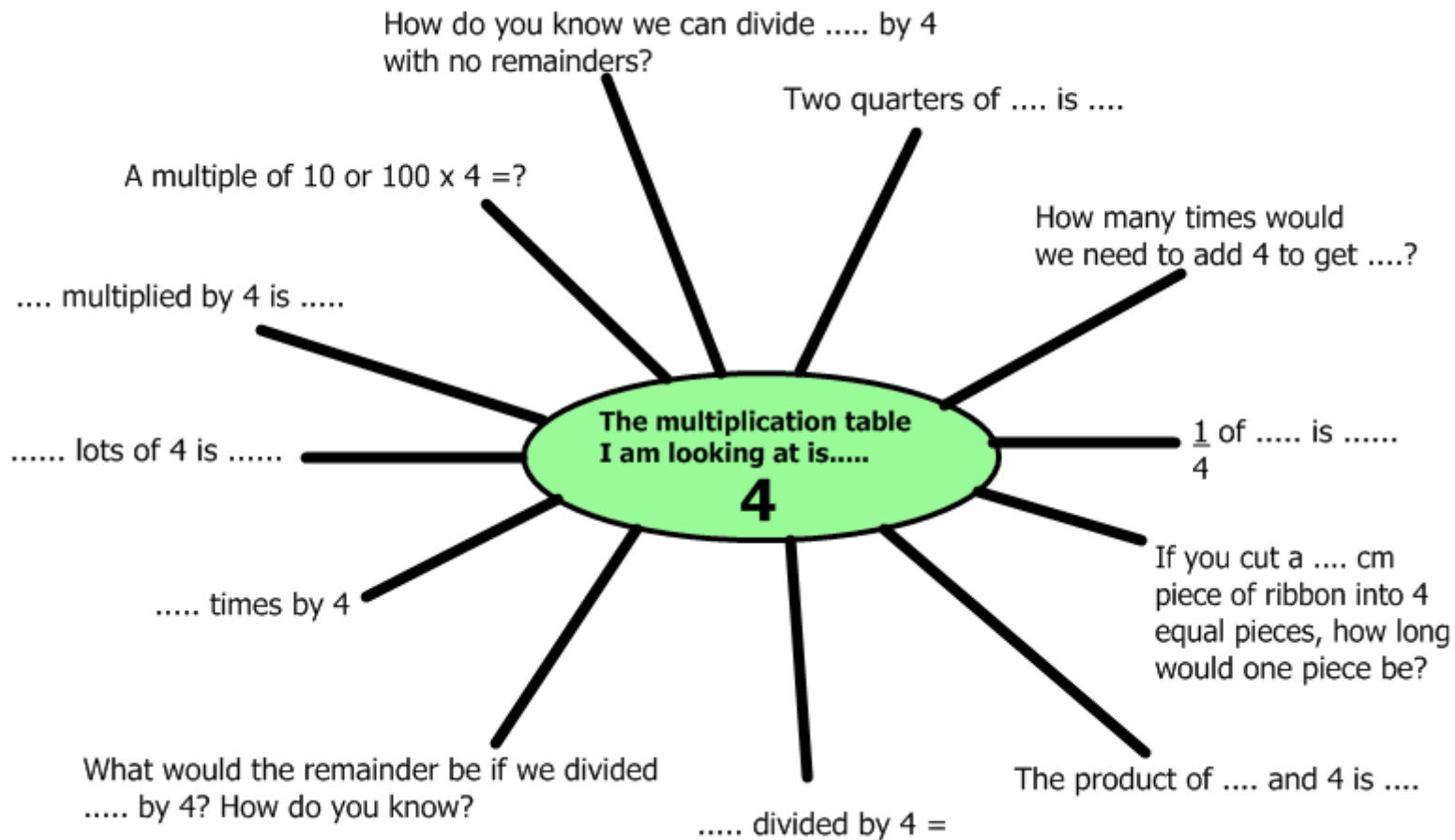
X 2 Tables – you don't have to do the 2 x tables. You can choose the x tables that are most challenging for you.



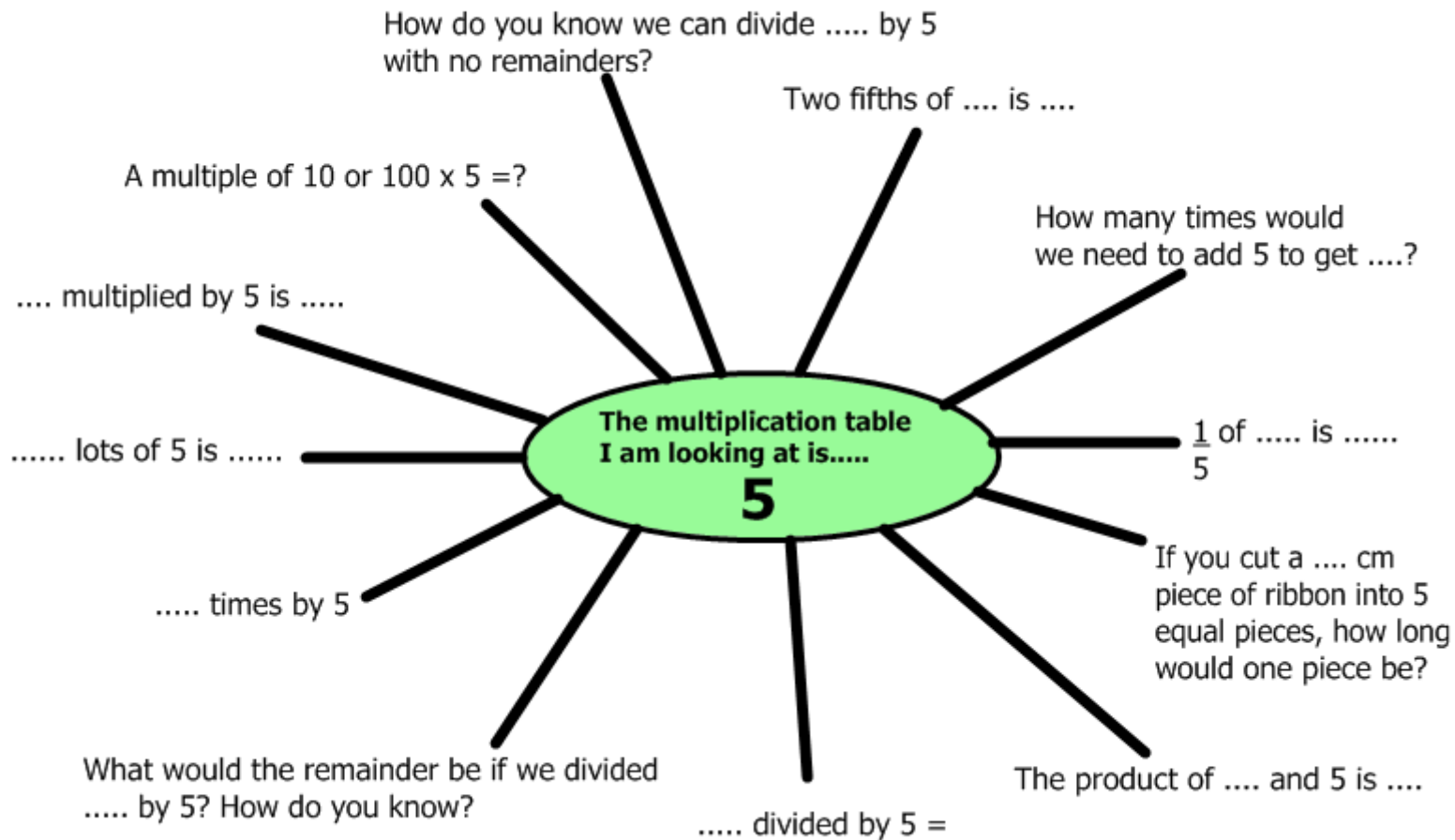
X 3 Tables



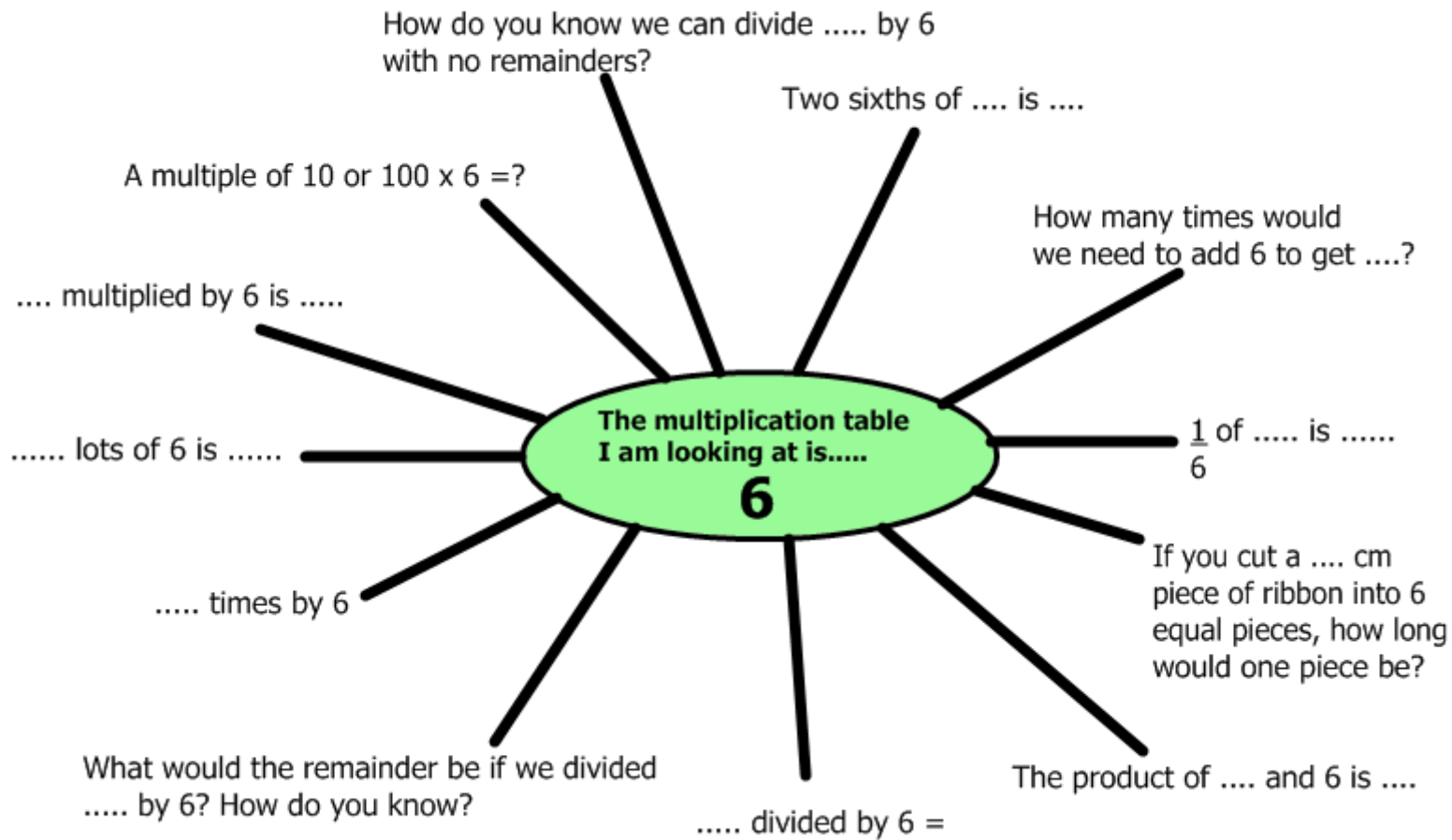
X 4 Tables



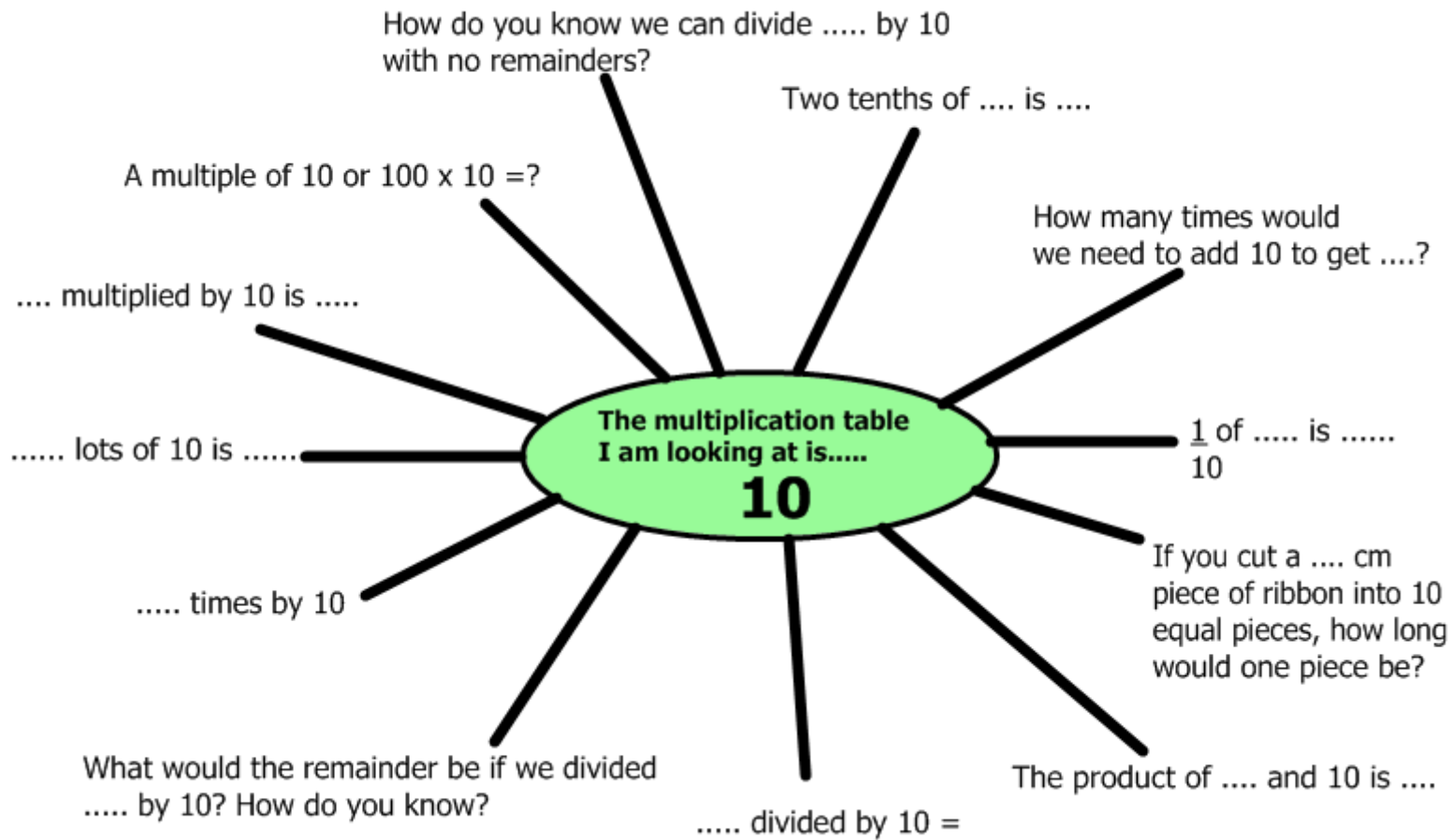
