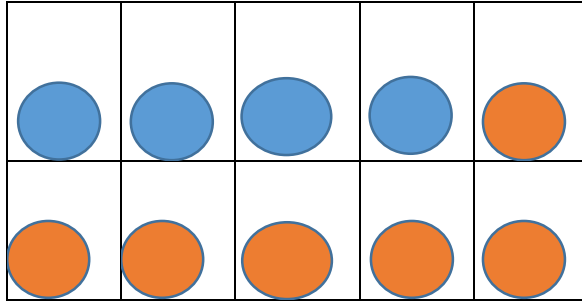


Tuesday 2nd March Year R - Home Learning

Maths- Play 'snowball skittles'. All you need are 10 plastic cups or empty bottles. Roll your 'snow-ball' and see how many you knock over. Show on your 10 grid how many were up and how many down.

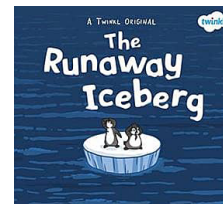
