



## Tuesday 26<sup>th</sup> January Year R - Home Learning

**Literacy-** Make a list of real life superheroes 'people who help us'. There is writing paper on the class webpage with some pictures to give you ideas.

*Children sound out the words and use their phonics. Eg police might look like this 'polees'.*

**Maths-** Following on from yesterday's 'making arrangements of numbers' activity, complete the sheet from the class webpage. It shows different images of numbers, spot the odd one out. Extending this, children can draw their own variety of different images to interpret numbers or amounts.



**Phonics-** Live lesson at 10am. Reading and writing together.

**PE** –Continuing with the cat moves we have been practising. You will need a range of items on the floor and use your cat or reverse cat pose to move and collect them. On the next page there are pictures to explain this.

**RE-** after hearing the story of Noah's ark (either the animation above or a version you have at home) complete the attached RE activity on the class webpage. Colour a rainbow (page 3) and write some things that you hope for on the colours.

*Additional maths link-* can you line items up in 2s and make pairs just like the animals going into the ark.
