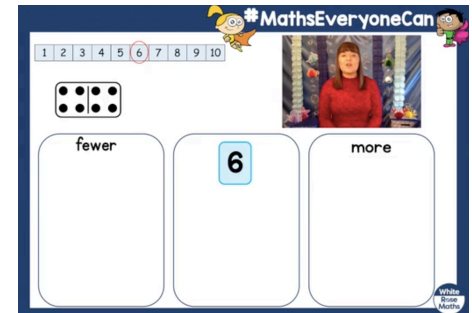


Wednesday 3rd March Year R - Home Learning
